Did you know?

- * Pre-school children reared in low socio-economic environments perform well below expected levels on a range of measures of oral language skills, in spite of comparable overall cognitive skills.
- *Oral language skills in the early years are very closely related to success in learning to read and write
- *Most academic tasks and social interactions rely on adequate oral language skills
- *In one study of young Australian male offenders, Snow and Powell (2008) found that over 50 percent of participants had significant deficits in oral language skills, many of which had been undetected during schooling.

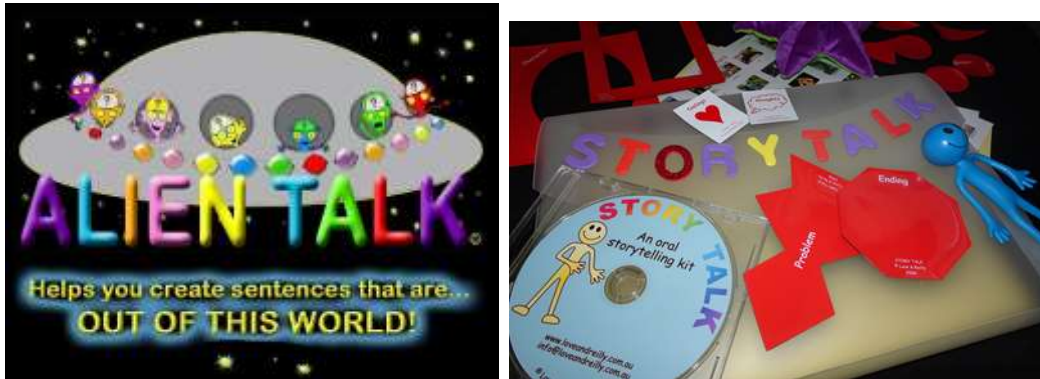

WHAT IS ORAL LANGUAGE?

Oral Language includes:

- understanding and expression
- the number of words a person can understand and can use (vocabulary)
- an awareness of the structure of words (phonological awareness and morphological awareness)
- the stringing of words together (to form sentences – both simple and complex)
- the structuring of these words in an ordered, clear and cohesive manner to tell a story (story grammar)

Without adequate oral language skills, a student’s reading comprehension and written expression is significantly impacted, even if they can “read” (decode) and spell every word.

NO! This workshop will not be heavy on theory.
